- Dovenby Beck safety issues around the latest planning application, no outcome yet, Mr Hodgson is in touch with the Highways Team about this. They have suggested that a gate would need to be 3 metres into the green to ensure that members of the public are not in the road whilst trying to access the village green. It was resolved that this would be further discussed at the next meeting in respect of any potential safety issues. **Clerk to circulate decision when it is received.**
